

Metaphysics

Let's solve some of the mystery of metaphysics. There are numerous examples of clairvoyance, esp, deja-vu, telepathy, psychokinesis, etc. that until now defied scientific explanation. I personally have performed tens of thousands of experiments in this field over a twenty-five year period. One of the more sophisticated experiments, specifically regarding telepathic communication can be easily repeated in laboratory situations by just about anyone at anytime, unlike most other parapsychological tests. I have therefore reached the following conclusions based on sound scientific principles.

Occasionally we glimpse at what appears to be the future, clairvoyance, but is only a glitch in our perception of the past. The real future hasn't occurred yet, so it is now and always will be impossible to perceive. This also pertains to the perception of channeling the "dead, or astrally projecting. These are still only memories and therefore perceivable through the phenomenon of the quantum glitch. What accounts for precognition is also only a memory of the past, slightly skewed in sequence by this quantum glitch in our perception. In feeling of having been there before, deja-vu, we really have been there before, only have not been totally conscious of it. Telepathy and synchronicity can also partly be an exchange of conscious awareness not fully in sync with real time passage and a quantum glitch awareness of self, temporarily as a wave, and not as an individual. The subtle forces involved in these phenomena, except telepathy, cannot be measured using our current scientific instrumentation. However they can be observed.
